
### MERRY CHRISTMAS Editorial







He is world renowned for his mathematical concepts like- mathematical analysis, infinite series, continued fraction and number theory. It was Professor Hardy who was totally impressed by his genius and thereafter decided to invite Ramanujan to the prestigious Cambridge University. Ramanujan is known to have published many papers with many of his works also having been published in the journal of Indian Mathematical Society. He was the youngest Indian selected for "A Fellow of Royal Society" in 1918 for his investigation in Elliptic functions and the Theory of Number.

Ramanujan belonged to a very humble background and had seen many hardships in life. Inspite of all the odds and obstacles he achieved such great feats in the field of Mathematics.


He will always be my role model and an inspiration for a lifetime.
