# **DID YOU KNOW**

## Oldest monuments in India

- 1. Attara Kacheri, Bangalore Attara Kacheri has served as the seat of justice for over a century, witnessing numerous legal proceedings and upholding Bangalore's judicial legacy.
- 2. Vivekananda Rock Memorial is a monument and popular tourist attraction in Kanyakumari, India's southernmost tip. It was built in 1970 in honour of Swami Vivekananda, who is said to have attained enlightenment on the rock.
- 3. Amar Mahal Palace, Jammu built in the 19th century on the right bank of the Tawi River, Amar Mahal Palace is dedicated to Raja Amar Singh. This majestic palace is an erstwhile residence of the Dogra Dynasty, which now has been converted into a museum.
- 4. The Red Fort of Old Delhi built in the 1630s, it is a work of art in red sandstone, intricate white marble inlay work, and combines both Persian and Mughal architectural styles.
- 5. Madhya Pradesh the great Stupa was installed in the 3rd century BC by Emperor Ashoka of the Mauryan dynasty. The sculptures and monuments present at the site are a fine example of the development of Buddhist art and architecture in Madhya Pradesh.

An Indian woman scientist, Director General of Aeronautical Systems and the former Project Director for Agni-IV missile in Defence Research and Development Organisation, Thomas is known as the 'Missile Woman' of India.


She is the first ever woman scientist to have led a missile project in India. Having grown up near the Thumba Equatorial Rocket Launching Station, her fascination with rockets and missiles began from there. With a Doctorate in missile guidance, Thomas has worked in this field for decades and was even awarded the Agni Self-Reliance Award in 2001.
