INSPIRATIONAL INDIANS ON GLOBAL MAP SACHIN TENDULKAR

Sachin Tendulkar (born April 24, 1973, Mumbai, India) is an Indian professional cricket player. Sachin Tendulkar became the first cricketer to score 100 centuries (100 runs in a single innings) in International Cricket history. At the age of around 17 years, he became India's youngest Test (International) Cricketer, making his debut against Pakistan in Karachi in November 1989. In August 1996, at age 23, Tendulkar was made captain of the Indian Cricket Team. In 2012, Tendulkar became the *First Active Athlete* to become a member of the Rajya Sabha, the Upper Chamber of the Indian Parliament. In 2014, he became the first sportsman to receive India's highest civilian honour, the **Bharat Ratna**. Sachin Tendulkar was inducted into the International Cricket Council Hall of Fame in 2019.



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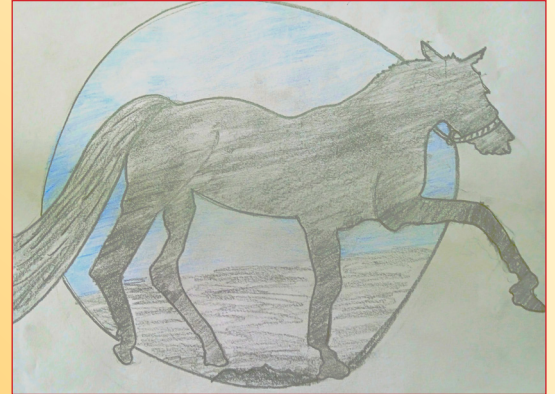
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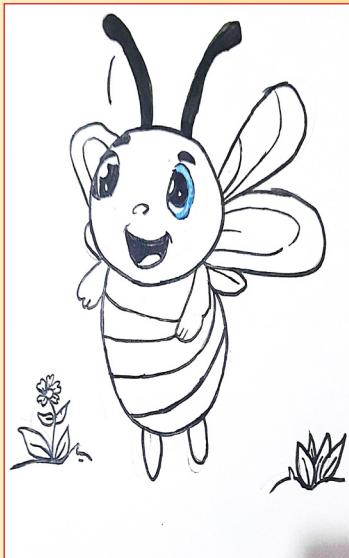
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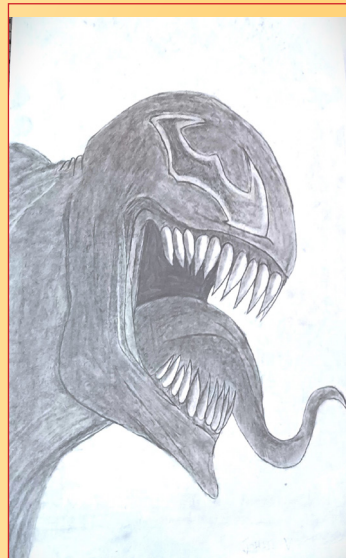
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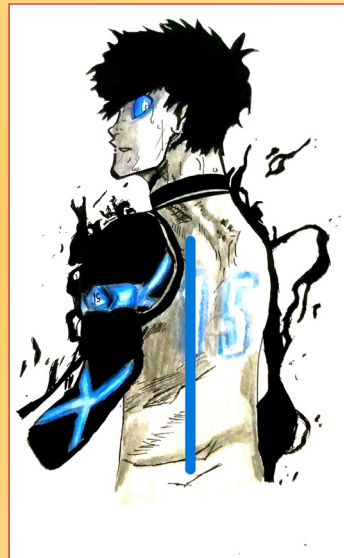
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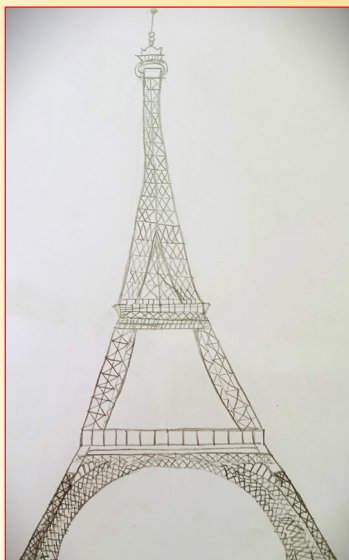
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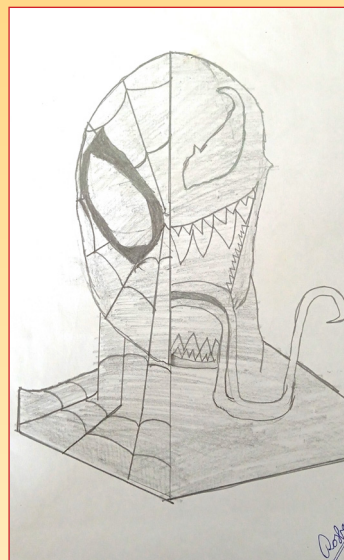
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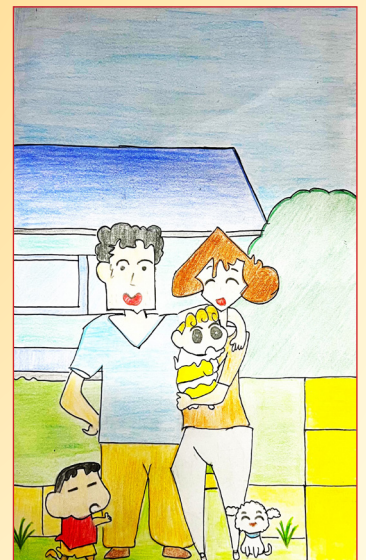
