

Yummy Cheere Garlic Bread

Ingredients

- Place the other slice of bread on top of this so that the outer sides have the layer of butter, coriander and garlic.
- Heat a tawa and put the bread on the tawa.
- Remove from the tawa and place it in a plate, once both sides become golden brown.
