Back to School

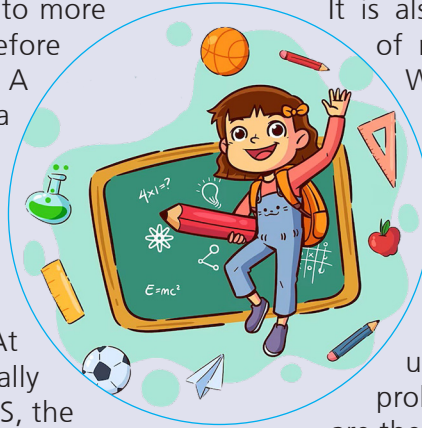
I am ecstatic and thrilled about academic year 2023-24 at school !

our daily lives. It is the true repository of our knowledge and values.



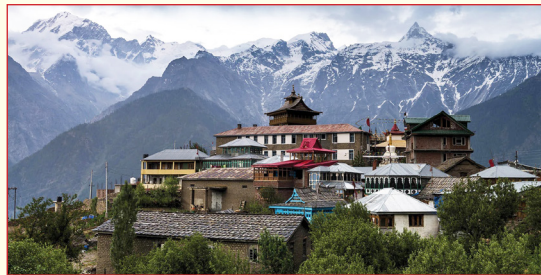
