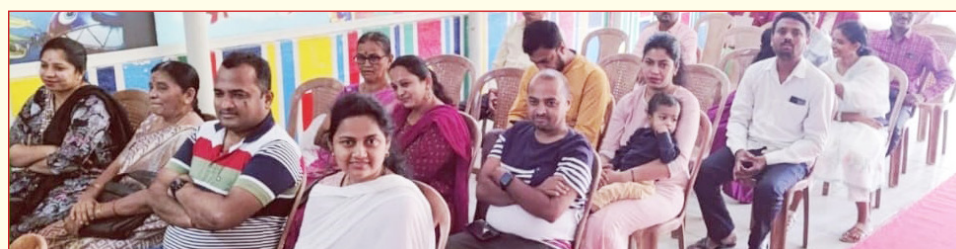

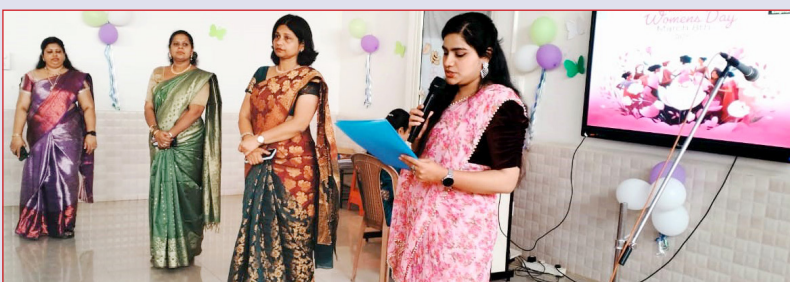
Women's Day – 8th March 2025

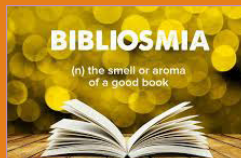

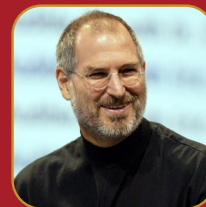

INSPIRATIONAL INDIANS ON GLOBAL MAP – AKRIT JASWAL World's Youngest Surgeon



Akrit Jaswal (born 1993) in Nurpur, Himachal Pradesh, is the world's youngest surgeon, performing a Burn-Surgery at age 7 in the year 2000. With an unprecedented IQ level of 146, Akrit Jaswal is considered the smartest person of his age in India. Akrit bewildered people at the age of 7 years, when he performed a burn surgery on a native girl who was suffering from burns on her hands, earning him the title of "World's Youngest Surgeon."

At just 12 years old, he became the youngest student at an Indian university, enrolling in Chandigarh College, to pursue a degree in Science. His passion for learning and dedication to research led him to the Indian Institute of Technology(IIT) in Kanpur, where he pursued a Master's degree in Bioengineering at the age of 23. Akrit Jaswal is inspiring young minds world-over with this commitment and sterling genius.

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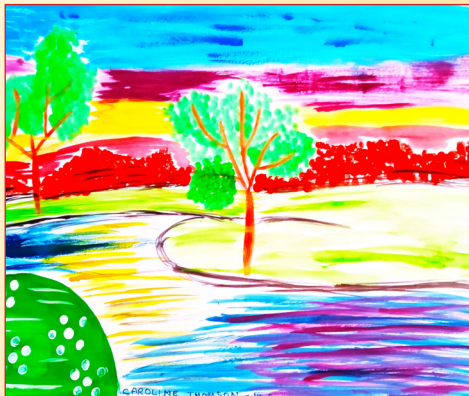
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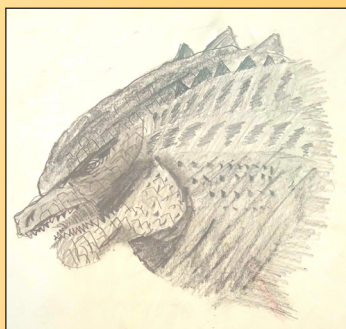
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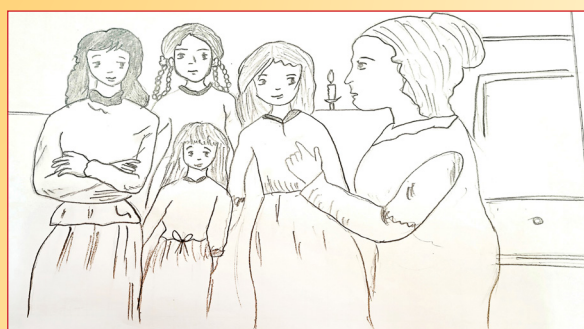
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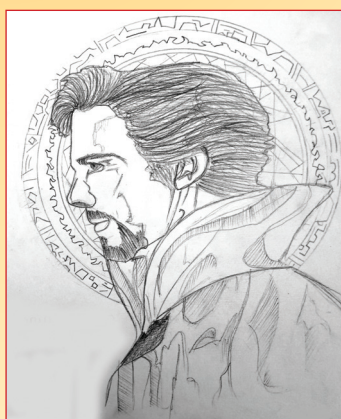
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
