

ಪ್ರತಿ ಕನ್ನಡಿಗನ, ಕರುನಾಡಿದ ಹೆಮ್ಮೆಯ ದಿನ ಕನ್ನಡ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವ. ಮೈಸೂರು ಪ್ರಾಂತ್ಯ ಎಂಬ ಹೆಸರಿನ ಮೂಲಕ ಕರೆಯಲ್ಪಡುತ್ತಿದ್ದ ಹಾಗೂ ವಿಭಾಗಗಳಾಗಿ ಚದುರಿದ್ದ ರಾಜ್ಯವು 1956 ನವೆಂಬರ್ 1 ರಂದು ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯವಾಗಿ ನಿರ್ಮಾಣವಾದುದರ ಸಂಕೇತವಾಗಿ ಈ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವವನ್ನು ಆಚರಿಸಲಾಗುತ್ತದೆ. ಅಂದಿನಿಂದ ಪ್ರತಿ ವರ್ಷ ನವೆಂಬರ್ 1 ರಂದು ನಾಡಿನಾದ್ಯಂತ ಕನ್ನಡ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವವನ್ನು ಆಚರಿಸಲಾಗುತ್ತಿದೆ. ಈ ವರ್ಷ ನಾವು 66 ನೇ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವದ ಸಂಭ್ರಮದಲ್ಲಿದ್ದೇವೆ. ಈ ಹಿನ್ನೆಲೆ ನಮ್ಮ ನಾಡಿನ ಬಗ್ಗೆ ಕೆಲವು ಸ್ವಾರಸ್ಯಕರ ಸಂಗತಿಗಳನ್ನು ತಿಳಿಯೋಣ.

ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದ ಹುಟ್ಟಿಗೆ ಕಾರಣರಾದ ಕನ್ನಡದ ಕುಲಪುರೋಹಿತ ಎಂದೇ ಹೆಸರಾದ ಆಲೂರು ವೆಂಕಟರಾವ್ ಅವರು ಮೊದಲಿಗೆ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಏಕೀಕರಣ ಚಳುವಳಿಯನ್ನು ಸ್ವಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯ ಪೂರ್ವವೇ 1905ರಲ್ಲಿ ಪ್ರಾರಂಭಿಸಿದರು. ನಂತರ ಭಾರತಕ್ಕೆ ಸ್ನಾತಂತ್ರ್ಯ ದೊರೆತು ಗಣರಾಜ್ಯವಾದ ನಂತರ ಭಾಷೆಗಳ ಆಧಾರದ ಮೇಲೆ 1956ರ ನವೆಂಬರ್ 1ರಂದು ರಾಜ್ಯಗಳನ್ನು ವಿಂಗಡಿಸಿದರು. ಅದರಂತೆ ಮದ್ರಾಸ್, ಮುಂಬಯಿ ಮತ್ತು ಹೈದರಾಬಾದ್ ಪ್ರಾಂತ್ಯದ ಕನ್ನಡ ಮಾತನಾಡುವ ಪ್ರದೇಶಗಳೆಲ್ಲವೂ ವಿಲೀನಗೊಂಡು ಮೈಸೂರು ರಾಜ್ಯ ಉದಯವಾಯಿತು. ಆದರೆ ಉತ್ತರ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದ ಜನರ ತರ್ಕ ಮಾನ್ಯತೆಗಾಗಿ, ರಾಜ್ಯದ ಹೆಸರು ನವೆಂಬರ್ ೧, ೧೯೭೩ ರಂದು "ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ" ಎಂದು ಬದಲಾಯಿತು. ಕನ್ನಡದ ಇತಿಹಾಸ, ಮಹತ್ವ, ಹೋರಾಟಗಳ ಬಗ್ಗೆ ಮುಂದಿನ ಪೀಳಿಗೆಗೆ ತಿಳಿಸುವ ಉದ್ದೇಶದಿಂದ ಹಾಗೂ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕದ ಏಕೀಕರಣಕ್ಕೆ ಹೋರಾಡಿದ ಕನ್ನಡ ರಾಜ್ಯೋತ್ಸವ ಮಹನೀಯರನ್ನು ಸ್ಮರಿಸುವ ಉದ್ದೇಶದಿಂದ ಅತ್ಯಂತ ಮಹತ್ವವನ್ನು ಪಡೆದುಕೊಂಡಿದೆ.



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
